1. Scope of Services

Provider agrees to supply qualified temporary staffing personnel as requested by Client. Personnel will be employees of Provider and assigned to Client based on mutually agreed-upon requirements, qualifications, and rates.

2. Rates and Billing

Hourly rates are as specified in the applicable cooperative contract rate schedule or as mutually agreed. Rates are fully burdened and include compensation, employer taxes, workers' compensation, general liability, and Provider overhead. Invoices are issued bi-weekly or monthly as agreed, with payment due Net 30.

3. Candidate Presentation

Provider will present qualified candidates within 4 business hours for common roles and 1 business day for specialized roles. Client retains the right to interview, accept, or reject any candidate.

4. Replacement Guarantee

If a placed worker is unsatisfactory, Provider will furnish a qualified replacement within 2 working days at no additional cost to Client.

5. Background Screening

Background checks, drug testing, and credential verification are available upon request and billed at direct cost with no markup. All screening follows FCRA-compliant processes.

6. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of proprietary information. Provider personnel will execute non-disclosure agreements as required.

7. Non-Solicitation

During the term and for 12 months after, neither party shall directly solicit or hire the other party's employees without prior written consent.

8. Insurance

Provider maintains Workers' Compensation, General Liability (\$1M/\$2M), and Professional Liability insurance. Certificates of insurance available upon request.

9. Compliance

Provider ensures all personnel comply with applicable laws, including FERPA, CIPA, CJIS, and Texas SB 820 as relevant to the assignment.

10. Term and Termination

This Agreement runs concurrent with the applicable cooperative contract. Either party may terminate with 30 days written notice. Client is responsible for hours worked through the termination date.
